CODE OF CONDUCT

This Code of Conduct is not subject to interpretation, delegates, guests and staff are expected to follow the code without exception. Adult chaperones, group leaders and staff are responsible for enforcing the conduct as stated. Violators may be asked to leave or sent home at their own expense.

Our primary consideration is to provide a safe, secure environment for all our delegates, guests and staff.

- Photo ID will be required upon registration.
- Attendance is mandatory at all sessions.
- Delegates must be respectful at all time.
- The Forum & Leadership Summit is a drug and alcohol-free event. Possession or use of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs is prohibited. This includes the grounds and streets surrounding the event.
- No gang endorsement or gang colors.
- Smoking or using other tobacco products is prohibited in all buildings, meeting rooms and guest rooms, unless it is for cultural purpose in designated area only. Smoking is permitted in designated areas and outdoor areas only.
- Lighting of candles and incense are prohibited in all buildings, meeting rooms, and guest rooms.
- Proper dress apparel is mandatory.
- Delegates must respect personal public property. Repair costs for damages incurred to property will be billed to the group responsible for such damages.
- Facility curfew is 11:00 pm. Delegates are asked to refrain from making noise in common areas and sleeping rooms between the hours of 11:00 pm and 7:00 am, which means visitors, need to be in their rooms at these times.
- To protect the safety of delegates, no fraternization is allowed in participant's accommodations after hours. Any participant who has a complaint regarding fraternization should contact conference coordinator.
- Before or during checkout, delegates must pay for all incidental charges.
